AAUW Members Show Support at Mansourian Trial

Mansourian v. Regents of the University of California, a case LAF has supported for six years, just wrapped up a three-week trial in federal court in Sacramento, California. More than a dozen AAUW members from the area attended. AAUW board member Alicia Hetman attended daily and hosted a potluck dinner for the plaintiffs and lawyers. Hetman said she arrived during Mansourian's testimony. "At lunch [Mansourian] told me that she was so happy when she saw me come in as it helped calm her down. ... I wish all AAUW members could feel the pride of hearing those kinds of comments from a litigant. It warms my heart and makes me dig deeper into my purse," said Hetman.
