A notice from AAUW California Board states, "AAUW does not sanction in-person meetings at this time nor for the foreseeable future. Our insurance coverage may allow meetings if waivers are signed, but exercising that option would likely be tested in court. AAUW's guidance is in adherence with California mandates and in the best interests of all our members. Let's remain safe today and enjoy gatherings in the future." So even though we can't physically come together at this time, we can come together in other ways to learn and raise funds for AAUW causes, both locally and nationally via Zoom and the U.S. Postal Service.

We will come together via Zoom for our October General Meeting to hear The League of Women Voters explain about the propositions on the November Ballot. 


